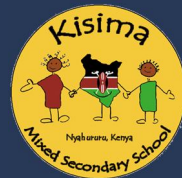


Gifts That Count

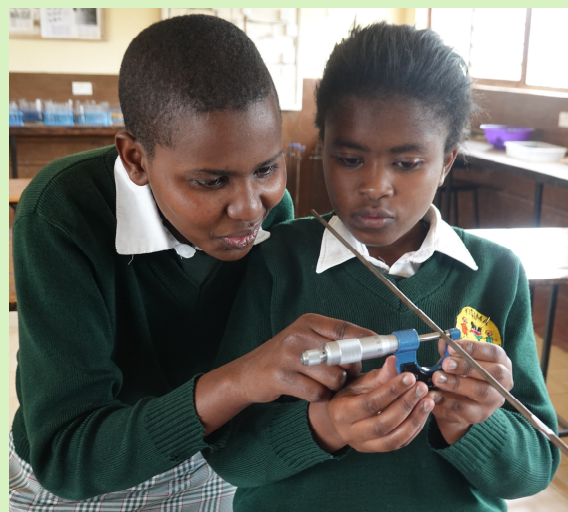

The chance to play sports, read a good book or enjoy time with friends over an indoor game enables students to relax in among their busy daily routines at Kisima.

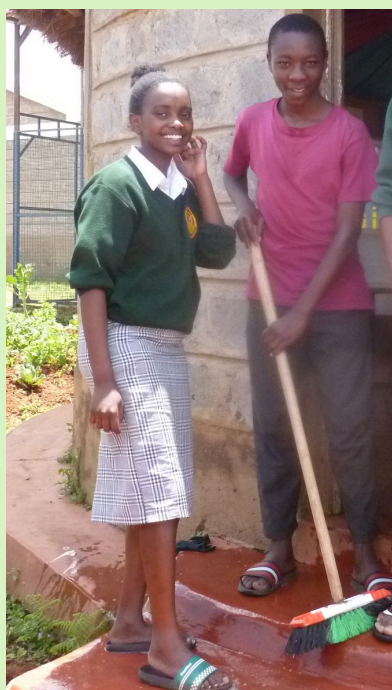
